

**Long Island Commission on Aquifer Protection  
Joint Subcommittee Meeting Notes**

**February 25, 2015**

**Suffolk County Water Authority  
260 Motor Parkway, Hauppauge, NY**

The following topics were discussed at this meeting.

**Plan Roadmap**

The tentative outline for writing the Long Island Groundwater Management Plan was discussed. There was extensive debate over the specific name of the Plan, largely based upon what the specific purpose of it is supposed to become once published in late 2017. It was explained that the Plan will address the major groundwater-related topics that were discussed at the five previous subcommittee meetings. Each topic will have its own report, authored by a member of one of the subcommittees, and these reports will constitute individual chapters of the Plan.

A basic conceptual outline of the Plan was shown, and was termed a “roadmap” for eventual completion of the Plan. The topics to be covered have been divided into two broad categories based upon which subcommittee to which they are most pertinent. The overall intent of the Plan is to afford an opportunity for people who are actual practitioners in some aspect of groundwater management on Long Island to author a report on their field of expertise.

**Plan Template**

The overall Plan outline was discussed. In addition, a template for the individual chapters of the Plan was discussed, and an actual paper authored by two employees of the USGS was shown as a sample of a properly formatted topic report.

**Chapter Assignments**

Members of the two subcommittees were then encouraged to sign up to author or co-author one of the reports. The “roster” of authors and reports is as follows:


